

2024 The Year Of The Harvest And Victory - Laws Of The Harvest

1. Get A Vision And A Strategy From Heaven

Hab 2:2 Write the vision, make *it* plain, that he may run who reads it.

Gen 41:25,39-40 God has revealed to Pharaoh in advance what he is about to do. 39 “Since God has revealed the meaning of the dreams to you, clearly no one else is as intelligent or wise as you are. You will be in charge of my court, and all my people will take orders from you. Only I, sitting on my throne, will have a rank higher than yours.”

2. Work The Plan With All Your Heart And Might As Unto The Lord

Prov 10:4-5 He who has a slack hand becomes poor, but the hand of the diligent makes rich. He who gathers in summer is a wise son; he who sleeps in harvest is a son who causes shame.

Ps 1:3 And whatever he does shall prosper (go forward, thrive, bloom).

Col 3:23-24 **Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.** (AMP) Knowing that it is from the Lord [not from men] that you will receive the inheritance.

3. Without Giving, There Is No Reaping - In 2024, Do It The Right Way

Gal 6:7 Whatever a man sows, **this and this only is what he will reap.**

2 Cor 9:6-7 Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

- We give because we love the Lord, and we give with expectation.
- Giving breaks curses, opens heaven's floodgates, releases blessing, brings divine protection, and causes the harvest to fully mature.

Mal 3:10-11 “Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the Lord Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it. I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not drop their fruit before it is ripe,” says the Lord Almighty.

Job 1:10 You have always put a wall of protection around him and his home and his property. You have made him prosper in everything he does. Look how rich he is!

4. Maintain A Strong Spirit Of Faith, While Waiting On His Perfect Timing

Gal 6:9 (NLT) So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessings if we don't give up.

Is 40:29-31 He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths will become weak and tired, and young men will fall in exhaustion. But those who wait (trust, expect) on the LORD will **renew their strength.** They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint.

Hab 2:2-3 (TLB) But these things I plan won't happen right away. Slowly, steadily, surely, the time approaches when the vision will be fulfilled. If it seems slow, do not despair, for these things will surely come to pass. Just be patient! They will not be overdue a single day!

Ps 126:5 Those who sow in tears shall harvest with joyful shouting.

Jn 10:10 **My purpose is to give them a rich and satisfying life.**
